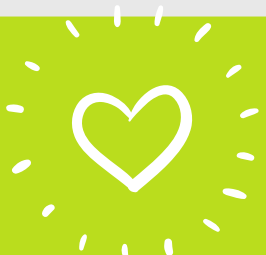
## WE ARE AN ADVOCATE FOR DOWNTOWN.

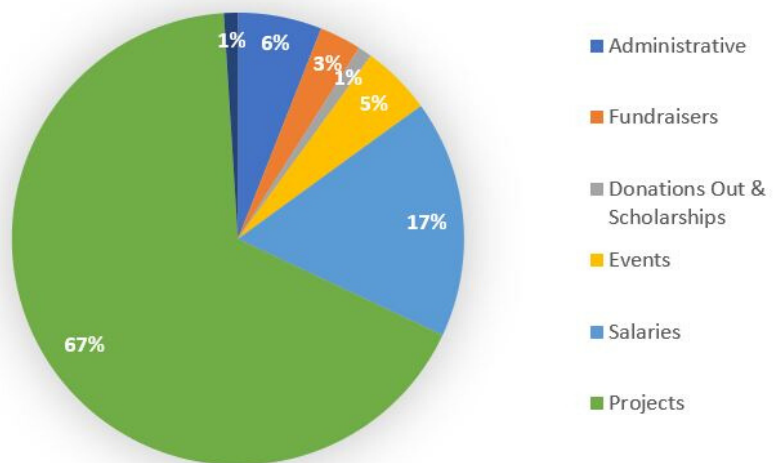
# 2019 FINANCIALS

Main Street programs are locally driven, funded, organized, and run. In other words, there is no money provided from a state or national program.

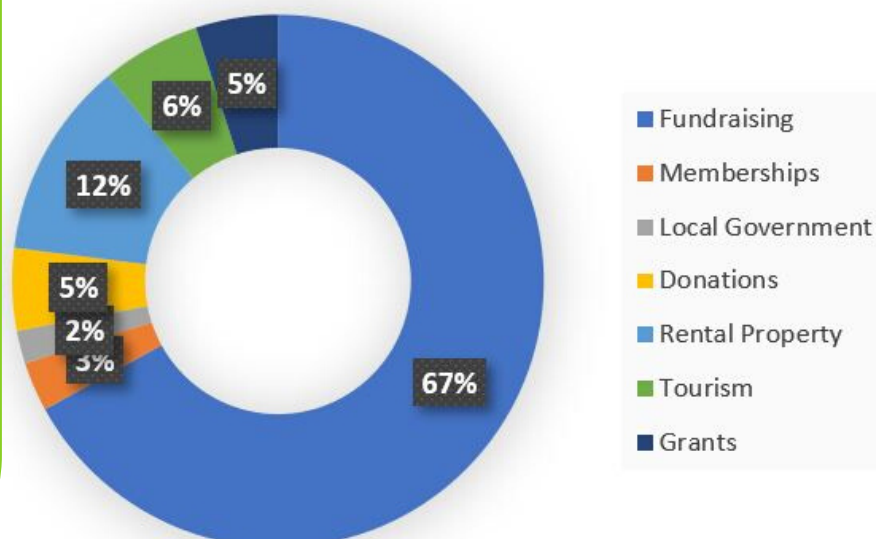
Guthrie Main Street is an independent nonprofit organization.
